There are several ways to register for a course that requires placement:

1. ACT score
2. A grade of “C” that is earned in any pre-core course before progressing to the next level
3. COMPASS score (a student may challenge the ACT Placement by taking the COMPASS English, Reading, or Mathematics Placement Test to determine the courses to be taken)
4. In-House Placement Test
5. Waiver signed. NOTE: **Signing a waiver (allowable only after placement testing) allows the student to move up only one course level and it does not change the prerequisite or co-requisite requirement for any other course.**
