- ❖ Have and maintain at least a 2.75 GPA (Applies to current HCC students)
- ❖ Maintain full-time status both fall and spring semesters next year (2015-2016)
- ❖ Have not been involved in any disciplinary action at Holmes Community College
- If selected, you must stay in contact with the sponsors to see if you are needed for any specific duties.

Students selected as Holmes Ambassadors must participate in the following activities unless excused by the Ambassador Advisor: (Transportation is provided for all out-of-town required events.)

- May 17-18 Meet & Greet 2-day In-service training with District-wide Ambassadors (Goodman Campus Overnight Stay Involved)
- ❖ May 27 Wood Registration for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester SS & Fall (1:00 to 3:00)
- ❖ May 29 Grenada Registration for 1st Semester SS & Fall (1:00 to 3:00)
- ❖ June 23– Grenada Registration for 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester SS and Fall (1:00 to 3:00)
- July 26-28 Ambassador Training -- APEX Leadership Training, University of Mississippi, Oxford (Overnight stay involved)
- ❖ July at least 1 work day around the middle of the month to prepare for Fall Registration (all day)

- ❖ August 13 Grenada Registration for Fall (1:00 to 5:00)
- August 18 Beginning of Late Registration Ambassadors Sign-up (All week beginning at noon & 4:00)

- District Wide-Call List 3 Ambassadors at-a-time Rotate weekly.
- One hour each week working with Ambassador sponsor.
- Additional school or community events as scheduled by the counselors, recruiting or administration.

Failure to abide by the above guidelines may result in the removal of the student as an Ambassador. If you are removed, all Ambassador items (clothing, name badge, etc.) must be returned immediately.
